Kwai Chung Hospital is a 920-bed, multidisciplinary, comprehensive centre for mental health care under the management of Hospital Authority. As one of the largest psychiatric hospital in Hong Kong, Kwai Chung Hospital offers a complete range of mental health care services for clients from the Kwai Chung, Tsing Yi, Tsuen Wan, North Lantau, Mong Kok, Sham Shui Po and Wong Tai Sin Districts.

Kwai Chung Hospital was built in 1981 with principles and models of care focused heavily on the institutional custody of patients with mental illness. With the evolution of psychiatric care, Kwai Chung Hospital has changed from the traditional hospital-based programs to early detection, treatment and community rehabilitation model for the mentally ill clients.

Apart from psychiatric services for adult psychiatric patients, it also develops psychiatric specialty services which include Child and Adolescent Psychiatric Services, Psychogeriatric Services, Substance Abuse Assessment Services and Services for Learning Disabilities.

Community-based services such as Community Psychiatry, Psychiatric Consultation Liaison and Child and Adolescent Mental Health Support Programmes, are also integral components of our hospital.

The hospital also provides out-patient department and day hospital services for psychiatric patients in West Kowloon Psychiatric Centre, East Kowloon Psychiatric Centre and Yaumatei Child Psychiatric Centre.

Our multidisciplinary team includes psychiatrists, nurses, clinical psychologists, occupational therapists, physiotherapists and dieticians. Our ultimate aim is to deliver personalized psychiatric services to patients through an integrated multi-disciplinary team approach, in collaboration with district community partners.
